 - i. Outdoor cart vs blocks for learning playground. We were having trouble with finding space for storage of blocks. We therefore, decided to do an outdoor cart with outdoor play supplies. (hula-hoops, balls, jump ropes bubbles chalk etc). Cart is about \$550

- the rest of the funds will be for supplies for the cart. Perhaps parents could bring by donations total cost this year \$1000
